

Molecular Biosciences Travel Awards

Deadline: Aug 22, 2017

Awards will be made for reasonable travel and expenses for MB graduate students who will present talks or posters at national or international meetings in their research area; or for training at national laboratories. Applications will be considered for travels on 8/29/2017- 01/23/2018. Priority will be given to students that have not received prior travel awards. We expect to grant 2 travel awards for this cycle. Submit application materials by email to R. De Guzman (rdguzman@ku.edu) by the deadline.

A. Each graduate student application must include, in a single PDF file:

1. A brief letter that includes the following information:
 - a. contact information, email address;
 - b. purpose of travel;
 - c. dates, location, and description of conference;
 - d. budget, limited to our maximum award of \$1,000;
 - e. description of any previous departmental travel support.
2. CV and grade transcript or DPR showing graduate classes and grades.
3. Title, Author/s, and Abstract that will be presented.

B. Each faculty advisor must provide a letter in PDF file attesting to the applicant's need and research progress. *If there are multiple applicants from a single lab, the letter must rank each applicant.* Preference is given to support only one student from each laboratory. Email this letter to rdguzman@ku.edu.

- There are three cycles for travel awards during the academic year (22 Aug 2017, 16 Jan 2018, and 10 Apr 2018).
- Complete the online Travel Request Form, ahead of your travel dates: <http://ssc.ku.edu/travel-request-form>. This is a university rule and is not used by the selection committee.
- Awards are given on a reimbursement basis. Submission of original itemized receipts are required for reimbursements.
